**SCHEDULING REMINDERS FOR STUDENTS  
2018-19**

1. If you wait till September to enroll, you may find full classes and long lines.
2. If you choose or change classes late (e.g. for Term 2), you may be charged add/drop fees and experience trouble or delays getting textbooks.
3. You need to be on campus August 29 to check in and complete arrival procedures.
4. Dorm students: You may return early only if you are in SS 261 Leadership Foundations/PA 372 Missional Leadership (August 16), or you are an Impact leader (August 20), or an Explore Intern (August 16). If you are not in one of these groups and you return more than 24 hours before the scheduled arrival date for returning students (August 29), dorm access may be restricted, and you will pay in advance for extra room and board (if available).
5. We reserve the right to cancel courses if enrollment is insufficient or for other reasons.
6. Remember that you are responsible to
  - a. Schedule the courses you need to fulfil graduation requirements;
  - b. Fulfill prerequisite requirements;
  - c. Enroll in at least the minimum number of credits required for scholarships, bursaries, student loans, or Student Authorization Documents (visas). Consult Doug Johnson if you're unsure.
  - d. Not sure what elective choices you have for next year? Just ask us!
7. To get ahead on your program, consider Distance Education courses (list [here](#)). US students on student loans can't take DE courses.
8. Returning next January? Register now.

10. The Academic Calendar will show you that we've shortened the Add/drop periods. Why? Faculty were finding it difficult to make optimum use of the first few class meetings with

students adding and dropping so far into the term. The shorter periods are consistent with what we found at other institutions (in proportion to total class time).
