

## Fall 2021 Term 1 Operating Restrictions

For the remainder of this current term the following changes to meet the requirements of Order 42-2021 will apply on campus.

1. Masks must be worn at all times while indoors. A faculty member may remove their mask while teaching, when more than 2 m of distancing from students can be achieved. Masks should be worn both in the classroom and in public spaces throughout all school buildings. The only exception to masking is “except while alone in work stations”. This exception applies to library study carrels or private offices only.
2. Classes – All classes require physical distancing. The furniture in our classrooms have been adjusted to reduce classroom capacity. Any change in classroom location has been posted by the Registrar’s Office. All classes are available via HyFlex at this time with the exception of Nursing Labs, Outdoor Leadership classes in Nordegg, Digital Media classes and Aviation Ground Schools and Flight Lessons.
3. Dining Room – all meals will be takeaway only for the remainder of Term 1.
4. Athletic Intramurals – all intramurals will be paused except where arrangements can be made to play out of doors.
5. Workouts – all workouts must be booked via the Google calendar. There will be restricted access to the workout room although there will be machines in 2 locations once again.
6. Chapels – all chapels will be moved to the Dining Room to meet capacity restrictions for the remainder of the term.
7. Library - Full masking and physical distancing is required in the Library. Even with the Restrictions Exemption Program in place, the Medical Health Officer of Alberta has stated that Libraries are not allowed to dispense with physical distancing.
8. Futsal Teams – Any member of a futsal team is welcome to practice throughout this term if they are vaccinated and have submitted documentation to confirm this. This is Prairie’s only vaccinated requirement in Term 1.

9. Cross-Country Teams – as Cross country is an outdoor sport, practices will continue without restriction. Participation in Cross-country meets will be determined by the restrictions issued by the Cross-Country Meet convenor.
10. Choir – Choir will be restricted to students only with physical distancing and masking requirements in effect. Any community or staff/faculty member who wishes to sing in the choir will be welcome to return for Term 2 if fully vaccinated.
11. Explore term at Frontier Lodge – the Explore team at Frontier Lodge will continue under the overnight camp restrictions issued by the Govt of Alberta. This means that the students and faculty at Frontier Lodge currently are a defined cohort. All faculty and students in this cohort will be required to remain at Frontier Lodge (FL) until the end of Fall Semester Term 1. The only exception to leaving the FL campus is for medical care or vaccination appointments. It is expected that no students or staff from main campus will visit the Nordegg campus while these restrictions are in place.
12. Impact Groups – As Prairie implemented last year, the impact group will be considered a school required cohort. All impact groups meeting in person will meet in a school classroom, board room or public space. Impact groups are welcome to meet online or out of doors as well.
13. Service – For the remainder of Term 1 (3 more weeks) Service cleaning on campus will be cancelled. It is recommended that Impact Groups serve the campus through creative means, ie: Prayer, encouragement, individual acts of service, individual cleaning. Service Cleaning will resume at the start of Term 2.
14. Lounges – the Upper Room will be closed to students due to the Social gathering restrictions under Order 42-2021. Dorm lounges can be used by students for Impact Group activities.
15. SU Events – SU events will operate with consideration to the current restrictions imposed with Order 42-2021 as will the Loft. It should be expected that most SU events will take place out of doors until this Order is lifted.
