POSITION MISSION:

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Develop or revise an online graduate level course in the relevant disciple in collaboration with the Program Director and Director of Online Education.
- Instruct the seven-week long course. This includes:
 - Hosting a weekly one (1) hour live instructional session.
 - Grade student work in a timely manner
 - Provide appropriate learning support for students
 - Submitting final grades for the course no later than one (1) week after the conclusion of the class.
- Participate in program specific discussions and evaluation as needed.
- Mentor and disciple students as you are able.
- Participate in course assessment.
- Promote the program as appropriate.
